- 3. WHAT AGENTS ARE DOING**
- Are agents knocking on doors or stopping people
  - Are they detaining anyone (who and where)
  - Did they show a judicial warrant
  - Are they attempting to enter private property
  - Are they refusing to identify themselves
- 4. WHAT TO KEEP IN MIND**
- Stay on public property
  - Do not interfere or block agents
  - Stay calm and avoid escalation
  - Keep your video as evidence
  - Keep the original unedited footage
  - Do not rename video files

**DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST** 

- 2. IDENTIFICATION DETAILS**
- Vehicle description (make, model, and color)
  - License plate number(s)
  - Law enforcement markings on vehicles
  - Law enforcement patches on uniforms
  - Are agents masked or hiding their identity
  - Are they in uniform or plain clothes

- 1. GENERAL INFORMATION**
- Date and time
  - Exact location (address, intersection, landmarks)
  - Description of agents present

**AVISO:** Activity, Vehicles, Identity, Site, Observed Time

Use this to document any immigration enforcement you see in your video.

**These are the details we need when reporting and filming.**

## IF THERE ARE MULTIPLE OBSERVERS ON SITE

Observers can split into roles to cover more ground.

### Possible roles

- **Walk or drive the perimeter-** Look for additional vehicles, agents, or movement.
- **Check nearby businesses-** Ask if they saw anything.
- **Note nearby schools, churches, childcare, or community spaces-** Agents have appeared near youth spaces before.
- **Coordinator-** One person updates the chat with real-time information.
- **Family contact-** One person connects with the family if needed and collects contact info.

We look out for each other. Document what you see, stay grounded, and help keep our community safe.

## OBSERVER GUIDE

## IF SOMEONE IS BEING DETAINED

PHRASES TO USE

*Things you can ask in Spanish or English*

These questions help us notify their family and make sure their belongings are safe.

- **“Cuál es tu nombre”** *“What is your name”*
- **“Cuál es tu fecha de nacimiento”** *“What is your date of birth”*
- **“Tienes un número de alguien para avisarle que estás detenido”** *“Do you have a number for someone we should notify”*
- **“Quieres que te lleve tus llaves del carro”** *“Do you want me to take your car keys”*

## AS AN OBSERVER

**Your main role is to document.**

- Film what you see clearly and calmly
- Say out loud: time, location, what agents are doing
- Keep your video steady
- Try to keep one continuous video

**Where you can stand**

- You have the right to watch and record with your phone
- You can get as close as you need to record clearly
- No set distance, just be responsible as you record
- You can stand anywhere the public is allowed to be
- If you are on private property open to the public (parking lot, storefront, gas station), agents cannot ask you to leave
- If a business asks you to leave, move to a public space and keep documenting

## IF QUESTIONING AGENTS

PHRASES TO USE

- **“Are you conducting immigration enforcement”**
- **“Do you have a judicial warrant. Can I see it”**
- **“Are you detaining someone. On what grounds”**
- **“Please identify yourselves. You are operating in public”**
- **“Why are your faces covered. Federal agents must identify themselves”**
- **“Are you aware that community members are observing this for transparency”**
- **“You are being recorded. You are refusing to identify yourself while detaining someone in public.”**

## AS AN OBSERVER

**What you can ask agents**

- Ask if they are conducting immigration enforcement
- Ask to see a judicial warrant
- Ask for their name and badge number
- Ask why someone is being detained and on what basis

**If agents are masked or refuse to identify themselves**

- Ask them to show ID
- Film it and clearly say they refused to identify themselves

**Keep yourself grounded**

- Your role is to witness, not escalate
